

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-11**

**WHEREAS**, Tallapoosa County was declared a Federal Disaster Area on April 27, 2011 after F4 tornadoes wiped out residential, agricultural and business areas inside the City limits of Dadeville, Alabama and

**WHEREAS**, the areas inside the City limits of Dadeville, Alabama affected by the F4 tornadoes run along US Highway 280 and the areas of Henderson Street, Black Street, Woodland Trace, Carla Drive and Smokerise and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Dadeville, Alabama entered into a contract with TAG Grinding on May 18, 2011 for "Disaster Debris Removal, Disposal and Reduction Services" and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dadeville amended the contract with TAG Grinding to better meet the needs of residents/citizens of the City of Dadeville, Alabama who were directly affected by the storms by providing Right-of-Entry forms for debris removal from private property and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Dadeville, Alabama has voted to amend the contract with TAG Grinding to include an additional 10,000 cubic yards of debris removal from the City Right of Way for private property which must be completed by July 12, 2011

Councilperson Goodman, made the motion and Richardson, a councilperson seconded the motion that said Resolution be approved, and said Resolution passed by majority vote of the Council and the Mayor declared the Resolution passed.
