

RESOLUTION # 11-14

WHEREAS, the Alabama Emergency Management Agency (AEMA) is accepting applications from municipal governments for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funds; and


WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville has identified the need for three generators to be located at Sewer Lift Stations No. 1 and No. 2 and the Madwind Pump Station to provide back-up power during future storm events; and

WHEREAS, Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc. estimates the total cost to be approximately \$500,000; and, if funded, the grant will pay 75% or \$375,000 and the City will be responsible for providing 25% or \$125,000 in cash or "in-kind" contributions.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the city of Dadeville authorizes the submission of a grant application to AEMA requesting \$500,000 in HMGP Funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the Mayor to sign all required grant application documents on behalf of the City.
