

RESOLUTION # 12-01

WHEREAS, the Alabama Emergency Management Agency (AEMA) is accepting applications from municipal governments for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funds; and


WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville has identified the need for three tornado sirens to provide residents with adequate emergency notification of future storm events; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the sirens is estimated to be approximately \$114,000; and, if funded, the grant will pay 75% or \$85,500 and the City will be responsible for providing 25% or \$28,500 in cash or "in-kind" contributions.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the City of Dadeville authorizes the submission of a grant application to AEMA requesting \$114,000 in HMGP Funds; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the Mayor to sign all required grant application documents on behalf of the City.
