WHEREAS, the Alabama Transportation Rehabilitation and Improvement Program (ATRIP) is accepting applications from municipal governments for Phase 1 Funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville has identified the need for rehabilitation of Lafayette Street within the City of Dadeville; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the work is estimated to be approximately \$1,324,980.51; and, if funded, the grant will pay 80% or \$1,059,984.41 and the City of Dadeville will be responsible for providing 20% or \$264,996.10 in cash or "in-kind" contributions.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the City of Dadeville authorizes the submission of a grant application to Alabama Department of Transportation requesting \$1,324,980.51 in ATRIP Funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the Mayor to sign all required grant application documents on behalf of the City.
