

RESOLUTION NO. 12-12

WHEREAS: The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires jurisdictions (states, counties, towns and special districts) to have a Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS: The Hazard Mitigation Plan is required to be updated every five (5) years to maintain eligibility for pre and post disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant funds administered by FEMA; and

WHEREAS: The City of Dadeville recognizes the vulnerability of its resources, property and operation to the impacts of disasters and emergencies and

WHEREAS: The Tallapoosa County Emergency Management Agency contracted with East Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission to create a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Tallapoosa County and the municipalities within the County, and


WHEREAS: By adopting a Hazard Mitigation Plan, the City of Dadeville will help ensure the long term viability of the City and lessen the effects of the City from recurring damage due to natural hazards, and
