

RESOLUTION NO. 14-09

**CITY OF DADEVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DADEVILLE as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville, (hereinafter called "City") met on Tuesday, April 22, 2014. A board member of the Dadeville Waterworks and Sewage Board is due to be re-appointed for a second term. The member is not a qualified elector of the municipality, but is a property owner within the corporate limits.

WHEREAS, the Mayor nominates candidates to the Waterworks and Sewage Board and the governing body appoints the board member. A question has arisen as to whether a city council member may nominate an individual to be appointed to the Waterworks and Sewage Board.

WHEREAS, the City Council unanimously agrees with the necessity of an Attorney General's Opinion in regards to this matter.

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes Robin Reynolds, City Attorney, to prepare a Request for Attorney General's Opinion in his capacity as said City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED The City of Dadeville adopts Resolution No.14-09 requesting an Attorney General's Opinion.

Council Member Mickey Tarpley, made the motion and Council Member Billy Monroe seconded the motion that said Resolution be approved, and said Resolution passed by unanimous vote of the City Council.
