Resolution No. <u>19-019</u> Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan

WHEREAS, During the 2019 Special Session, in an effort to address infrastructure funding, the Legislature passed House Bill 2 which increased the motor fuel tax by 6 cents in 2019, 2 additional cents in 2020, and 2 additional cents in 2021, which designates for the 10 cent Gasoline Tax; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville is to receive a portion of the said tax in an approximate amount of \$21,477 the first year, \$28,635 the second year, \$35,794 the third year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville pledges to keep this money in a separate fund allowing funds to accrue for future use and expend only for maintenance and improvement of roads and bridges; and

THEREFORE, **RESOLVED** that the City of Dadeville, Alabama hereby adopt an annual Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan for funds received from additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel
