**TALLAPOOSA COUNTY ALERT SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Dadeville has voted and approved to remove the existing weather sirens;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Dadeville has declared the weather sirens to be outdated and expensive to repair; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Dadeville has voted and approved that the Tallapoosa County Alert System implemented through the Tallapoosa County Emergency Management Agency shall be the new alert system used throughout the city for citizens to receive information quickly in a variety of situations, such as severe weather, unexpected road closures, missing persons and evacuations of buildings and neighborhoods; and

**WHEREAS**, citizens have the option to enroll in the Tallapoosa Alert System to receive time-sensitive messages through their mobile device via text message and phone, home and business phone and through email address;


