ORDINANCE NO. 20-001 502

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DADEVILLE, ALABAMA, ESTABLISHING THAT THE MONTHLY SALARY OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS SHALL REMAIN AS IS, WITH NO INCREASE, EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 2, 2020

AN ORDINANCE by the City Council of the City of Dadeville, Alabama, as follows:

WHEREAS, the City has conducted an analysis of the Mayor and Council's compensation in comparison to other cities in the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is approved and adopted pursuant to and in accordance with §11-43-80(b) and §11-43-2, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended.

Section 1. That the salary of the mayor of the City of Dadeville, Alabama, shall be and remain the same as spread in the minutes of February 14, 2012 as last increased at the sum of \$1200.00 per month.

Section 2. That each councilmember shall be and remain the same as spread in the minutes of February 14, 2012 as last increased compensated for \$162.50 per meeting attended not to exceed \$325.00 per month;

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective November 2, 2020, and shall continue in force and effect until repealed by action of the council.

Section 4. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable; if any portion of this resolution shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.
