

SUMMARY OF CITY COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY, APRIL 14, 2020  
AS PER GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMATION OF MARCH 18, 2020  
UPDATED GUIDANCE ON OPEN MEETINGS ACT - COVID-19

Mayor Smith called the regular session of Council meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

The City Council of the City of Dadeville met in a regular session in the conference room of the City Hall on April 14, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. Those present were: Mayor Smith, Councilpersons Brownie Caldwell, Adams, Wolfe, Mathis and Councilperson Teneeshia Goodman-Johnson. City Attorney Robin Reynolds was present.

Mayor Smith presided and stated the meeting was open for the transaction of any business that might come before the Council. Mayor Smith led the attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilperson Mathis gave the invocation.

OLD BUSINESS: Update on Courthouse Square Project - landscaping has been done; Tallassee Street base is waiting on approval from ALDOT; hand rails should be installed within next 10 days.

NEW BUSINESS: Ordinance No. 503- The Dadeville Public Library Property No Longer Needed for Public or Municipal Purposes - Roll call vote to consider Ordinance No. 503 - Councilperson Johnson, yes; Caldwell, yes; Mathis, yes; Adams, yes; and Councilperson Wolfe, yes. By unanimous vote of yes to consider Ordinance No. 503.

Motion to adopt and approve Ordinance No. 503 - The Dadeville Public Library Property No Longer Needed for Public or Municipal Purposes was made by Councilperson Caldwell, seconded by Councilperson Johnson. Roll call vote: Councilperson Johnson, yes; Caldwell, yes; Mathis, yes; Adams, yes; and Councilperson Wolfe, yes. Motion carried by unanimous vote of yes to approve.

Discussion on the Families First Response Coronavirus Act (FFRCA) and the current personnel policy Family Medical Leave ACT (FMLA) on amending the current policy to include intermittent leave. Also, discussion on the FFRCA as it allows employers to exclude "emergency responders" from the new FFRCA.

Motion to not exclude or exempt emergency responders or essential personnel to the FFRCA was made by Councilperson Mathis, and seconded by Councilperson Adams.

Motion to suspend the rules to consider amending personnel policy to include intermittent leave under FMLA rules was made by Councilperson Johnson, and seconded by Councilperson Caldwell. Motion to amend by ordinance the personnel policy at next council meeting to make intermittent leave available under FMLA rules was made by Councilperson Mathis, and seconded by Councilperson Adams. Motion carried, non-opposed.

Discussion on small cell tower restrictions and regulations placed on them by ordinance; Attorney Reynolds will review sample ordinance, to have ordinance for review by next council meeting.

Street maintenance grass cutting bid letters will be sent out requesting bids after motion was made by Councilperson Caldwell, and seconded by Councilperson Johnson. Motion carried, non-opposed.

Rec Center Rentals: One was approved pending rules and regulations of the rec center after motion was made by Councilperson Caldwell, and seconded by Councilperson Wolfe. Motion carried, non-opposed.

Motion to pay bills was made by Councilperson Johnson, and seconded by Councilperson Caldwell. Motion carried, non-opposed.

Motion to adjourn was made by Councilperson Johnson. And seconded by Councilperson Wolfe. Motion carried, non-opposed.
