

ORDINANCE NO. 499-B
AMEND ORD. NO. 499

2020 “BACK-TO-SCHOOL” SALES TAX HOLIDAY
JULY 17-19, 2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DADEVILLE, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN “COVERED ITEMS” FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE “BACK-TO-SCHOOL SALES TAX HOLIDAY” AS AUTHORIZED 40-23-210 THROUGH 40-23-213, CODE OF ALABAMA 1975.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DADEVILLE, ALABAMA TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 499 DATED 2/27/18 TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In conformity with the provisions 40-23-210 through 40-23-213, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the City Council of Dadeville, Alabama, has affirmatively voted to grant the exemption of municipal sales and use taxes on certain purchases covered by 40-23-210 through 40-23-213, Code of Alabama 1975 during the third full weekend of July 2020, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, July 17, 2020 and ending at twelve midnight on Sunday, July 19, 2020.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by 40-23-210 through 40-23-213, Code of Alabama 1975, except that the time period shall only be as specified in Section 1 above.


Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Dadeville, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon approval and publication as required by law.
