That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of <u>MAYOR</u>, and that <u>FRANK</u> <u>GOODMAN</u> and <u>WAYNE SMITH</u> received the most and second most votes cast for that office, therefore, a runoff election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended.
