

RESOLUTION NO.: 21-010

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE COVID-19 MASK MANDATE FOR CITY BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) has been detected in our State, County and City; and

WHEREAS, by Order of the State Health Officer, the state-wide mask mandate has been suspended effective April 9, 2021; however, vulnerable persons are encouraged to exercise personal responsibility in slowing the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) poses a significant widespread risk and harm to our employees and staff; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Dadeville, to further mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and to protect city employees and staff, the mask mandate will continue in all city buildings until (date) 1st day of July, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Dadeville, Alabama, that the mask mandate be extended for all city buildings after Councilperson Johnson, made the motion and Councilperson Caldwell seconded the motion that said Resolution be approved, and said Resolution passed by majority vote of the Council and the Mayor declared the Resolution passed.
