

RESOLUTION NO. 21-015

**TO AUTHORIZE A SINGLE PAYMENT OF RETROSPECTIVE PREMIUM PAY PER THE CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS TO REGULAR FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME CITY EMPLOYEES
MARCH 2020 – MARCH 2021**

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville has an allocation from the American Rescue Plan Act 2021 through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

WHEREAS, since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, extraordinary demands have been placed on City of Dadeville Employees to meet the daily needs of our community; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Goodman recognizes that City of Dadeville Employees are essential workers; that they worked tirelessly together to keep the city functioning throughout the pandemic; that they regularly performed in-person work, interacted with others at work, or physically handled items handled by others; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund permits and encourages employers to use said funds to offer retrospective premium pay to essential workers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to recognize the contributions and compensate said City employees by providing a single payment of \$ 1700.00 to each current regular full-time employee and \$ 850.00 to each current regular part-time employee employed from March 2020 through March 2021.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Dadeville hereby authorized a single payment, of \$ 1700.00 to each current regular full-time employee and \$ 850.00 to each current regular part-time employee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said payments are to be funded through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds following the first full pay period after the receipt of said funds with a separate check, and is subject to all usual and customary taxes and deductions.
