

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-017**

**TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF TWO THERMAL IMAGERS FOR THE DADEVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE FIGHT AGAINST VIOLENT CRIME, GUN VIOLENCE AND IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY.**

**WHEREAS**, President Biden, along with Alabama Attorney General Steve Marshall urges state and local appropriators to prioritize American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for violent crime reduction; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dadeville has an allocation from the American Rescue Plan Act 2021 through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dadeville recognizes that each and every citizen has the right to live free from the fear of violence and crime, and improved public safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund permits and encourages employers to use said funds in the fight against violent crime, gun violence, and improve public safety.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Dadeville hereby authorized the purchase of two (2) thermal imagers for the Dadeville Police Department in the fight against violent crime, gun violence and improve public safety in the amount of \$ 13,768.00.
