

RESOLUTION NO. 22-001

TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF ESSENTIAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE DADEVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE FIGHT AGAINST VIOLENT CRIME, GUN VIOLENCE AND IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY.

WHEREAS, President Biden, along with Alabama Attorney General Steve Marshall urges state and local appropriators to prioritize American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for violent crime reduction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville has an allocation from the American Rescue Plan Act 2021 through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville recognizes that each and every citizen has the right to live free from the fear of violence and crime, and improved public safety; and


WHEREAS, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund permits and encourages employers to use said funds in the fight against violent crime, gun violence, and improve public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Dadeville hereby authorized the purchase of 8 tasers, 5 taser holsters, 2 cartridges, 1 battery, 5 body camera's, 2 door rams, 2 ballistic shields, 2 halogen tools, 1 ballistic helmet, 1 level 3 vest and 1 swat belt for the Dadeville Police Department in the fight against violent crime, gun violence and improve public safety in the amount of **\$22,678.67**.
