

**ORDINANCE NO. 312-A**  
**AMENDING**

**ORDINANCE NO. 312**

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council to amend the existing Ordinance governing the Beautification Board (hereinafter the "Board") of the City of Dadeville to provide for the current environment of enhancement for the City of Dadeville;

Section 1. **WHEREAS**, the current City Ordinance does not reflect the current needs of governance by the city of the Board members and its duties and mission;

Section 2. **WHEREAS**, the City Council hereby amends Ordinance 312 to provide for more comprehensive oversight of the Board and its members as follows:

Section 3. The membership of the Board of the City of Dadeville shall be amended to consist of 15 members, one member to be a member of the city council. Each member shall serve a term of one (1) year beginning October 1, and ending on September 30<sup>th</sup> (the fiscal year). The Board shall submit to the City Council a list of fifteen (15) persons to be approved and appointed during the 4<sup>th</sup> week of September of each year.

Section 4. The object of the Board shall not change.

Section 5. Section three (3) of the ordinance shall be amended as follows: The Board shall make written recommendations to the City Council of the City of Dadeville in regard to beautification aspects as related to the City and shall act as liaison for persons who wish to make complaints to the City Council. The Board shall make recommendations to the City Council for resolution of and complaint.

Section 7. Members of the Board shall receive no compensation for their services as such members.

Section 8. The Board shall meet at least monthly and a representative of the Board shall attend one City Council meeting per month to submit a report of its activities to the Mayor and Council. The Board shall submit an annual report to the Mayor and Council the second week of September of each year.


Section 9. The provisions of this article are declared to be severable. If any portion of this article shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the remaining portions of this article nor render the remaining portion of this article invalid.

Section 10. This Amended Ordinance shall become effective upon publication


