## Dadeville Police Department Job Description

The purpose of this position is to protect life and property and the enforcement of federal, state, and local laws. Job duties consist of related law enforcement duties.

- Law Enforcement includes, but not limited to, patrols of our city to detect and deter criminal activity and enforcement of traffic violations.
- Responds to calls for service and accurately completes all required reports.
- Apprehension and arrests of offenders of misdemeanor and felony offenses.
- Preliminary criminal and traffic investigations.
- Appearing and testifying at judicial proceedings.
- Assisting motorist, directing traffic, and other related functions related to general patrol duties.
- Other duties as assigned by the Chief of Police or department supervisors.

### Requirements – Certified Applicants

- Must meet all minimum requirements of the Alabama Peace Officers and Standards Commission.
- High school diploma or GED recognized by the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission.
- Must pass background checks, drug screening, physical examination, and psychological evaluation.
- Must be proficient in firearms with minimum qualification score of 70.
- Must possess good communication skills.

### Requirements – Non-Certified Applicants

- Must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
- Must possess valid Alabama driver's license.
- High School diploma or GED recognized by the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission.
- Must pass background checks, drug screening, physical examination, and psychological evaluation.
- ACT WorkKeys assessment, also known as BAT, required or possess an Associates degree or higher.
- Must be able to pass written examination.
- Must be able to pass physical agility in accordance with the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission.
