

ORDINANCE NO. 489

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DADEVILLE OF DADEVILLE, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE LAST FULL WEEKEND OF FEBRUARY, AS AUTHORIZED BY 40-23-230 THROUGH 40-23-233, CODE OF ALABAMA 1975, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE STATE SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS SALES TAX HOLIDAY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DADEVILLE COUNCIL OF DADEVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In conformity with the provisions in 40-23-230 through 40-23-233, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for a State Severe Weather Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday, the City of Dadeville of Dadeville, Alabama exempts "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the last Friday in February 2016, (February 26, 2016) and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday (February 28, 2016).

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by 40-23-230 through 40-23-233, Code of Alabama 1975, except that the time period shall only be as specified in Section 1 above and **not for all years thereafter**.

Section 3. The City of Dadeville Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Dadeville of Dadeville, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on Oct. 13th, 2015.
