

RESOLUTION NO. 10-05

**STATE OF ALABAMA
CITY OF DADEVILLE**

WHEREAS, the Trade and Globalization Adjustment Assistance Act of 2009 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 established the Community Trade Adjustment Assistance Program to provide communities with comprehensive and flexible solutions to a wide variety of trade impacts; and

WHEREAS, Tallapoosa County, Alabama is designated as significantly impacted for workers by the Economic Development Administration (EDA), United States Department of Commerce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Dadeville, Alabama, a subdivision of Tallapoosa County, supports Tallapoosa County's efforts to implement a project that:

- Strengthens regional cluster strategies and supports innovation and entrepreneurship consistent with the "Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy for the East Alabama Region (Alabama Region IV)" that was prepared in September of 2009 by the East Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission, an EDA designated Economic Development District;
- Yields a high return on investment;
- Supports global trade and competitiveness; and
- Supports the "green economy."

Councilperson Foster, made the motion and Richardson councilperson seconded the motion that said Resolution be approved, and said Resolution passed by majority vote of the Council and the Mayor declared the Resolution passed.
