

RESOLUTION NO. 13-04

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville, Alabama directly contacted known qualified firms in order to obtain proposals for the provision of engineering services for CDBG Project No. LR-CM-PF-12-008 , and

WHEREAS, based on the City's rating of all proposals received, using the City's rating system, Goodwyn, Mills & Cawood, Inc. has been deemed most qualified for the services called for and the proposed contract price is considered appropriate and reasonable, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Dadeville, Alabama to enter into a contract with Goodwyn, Mills & Cawood, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dadeville, Alabama as follows:


SECTION 1. That based on the City's understanding of procurement policies of ADECA, the acceptance of the proposal of Goodwyn, Mills & Cawood, Inc., for the provision of professional services for CDBG Project No. LR-CM-PF-12-008 has been determined to be in the best interest of the City of Dadeville, Alabama and that the proposed fee has been accepted as reasonable based on the complexity of the project and the amount and nature of the local match to be provided by the City.

SECTION 2. That the City of Dadeville, Alabama enters into an agreement with Goodwyn, Mills & Cawood, Inc. for the provision of engineering services, with said agreement attached hereto.


SECTION 3. That this action is based on the current interpretation of ADECA procurement policy which is acknowledged by this resolution and ADECA policy on file.
