

RESOLUTION NO.: 17-10  
AMENDING BYLAWS ARTICLES I, II & III OF THE DADEVILLE SENIOR CENTER

WHEREAS, the City of Dadeville has adopted Resolution Number 17-10 to amend Article I (2), Article II (2) and Article III (1) of the Bylaws of the Dadeville Senior Center and;

WHEREAS, the current Dadeville Senior Center Bylaws Article I (2) adopted on April 14<sup>th</sup>, 1997 states that the area served is Dadeville and surrounding area and;

WHEREAS, the current Dadeville Senior Center Bylaws Article II (2) adopted on April 14<sup>th</sup>, 1997 states to be an advocate group for the elderly population of Dadeville and surrounding area and;

WHEREAS, the current Dadeville Senior Center Bylaws Article III (1) adopted on April 14<sup>th</sup>, 1997 states that the membership shall include low income and older minority in proportion to the number of minority older persons in Dadeville and surrounding area and;

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Dadeville Senior Center Bylaws Article I (2) shall read that the area served is the City Limits of Dadeville and;

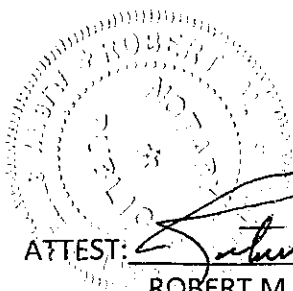
WHEREAS, an amendment to the Dadeville Senior Center Bylaws Article II (2) shall read to be an advocate group for the elderly population of the City Limits of Dadeville and;

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Dadeville Senior Center Bylaws Article III (1) shall read that the membership shall include low income and older minority in proportion to the number of minority older persons in the City Limits of Dadeville;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dadeville, Alabama, that the Dadeville Senior Center Bylaws Article I (2), Article II (2) and Article III (1) shall be amended, effective June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

Councilperson Haroldson made the motion and Johnson a Councilperson seconded the motion that said Resolution be approved, and said Resolution passed by majority vote of the Council and the Mayor declared the Resolution passed.
