

ORDINANCE NO. 511

CODIFYING INTO THE CITY OF DADEVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE THE LONGSTANDING AD VALOREM TAX MILLAGE TAX RATE OF THE RATE OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (5 MILLS)

WHEREAS, During a recent State of Alabama Audit of the Tallapoosa County Revenue Commissions Office and Probate Office, it was discovered that a copy of the City of Dadeville's ordinance codifying the ad valorem tax rate of one-half of one percent (5 mills) was needed. Subsequently a request was made by the Tallapoosa County Revenue Commissions Office and Probate Office for the documentation.


WHEREAS, After an extensive search of the records dating back to the 1980's, a physical copy of the ordinance setting the ad valorem tax rate of one-half of one percent (5 mills) when such ordinance was passed, adopted and approved could not be located.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 216 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 it is necessary to have documentation of the ad valorem tax rate in the City of Dadeville municipal code and on the official record.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Dadeville, Alabama as follows:

That the longstanding City of Dadeville ad valorem millage tax rate is the rate of one-half of one percent (5 mills).
