RESOLUTION 23-016

TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF MCKELVEY PARK POLES AND LED LIGHTS USING THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS (ARPA) TO IMPROVE OUTDOOR RECREATION SPACE; TO PROMOTE HEALTHIER LIVING ENVIRONMENTS AND OUTDOOR SPACES AND SOCIALIZATION TO MITIGATE THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

WHEREAS, federal legislation known as the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 provides among its many components, relief funds for local governments in the improvement of public outdoor spaces to promote healthier living environments and outdoor spaces and socialization to mitigate the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the City Council being desirous of providing and investing in improving outdoor spaces, and to be responsive to the needs of disproportionately impacted communities by investing in parks and other public outdoor recreation spaces to promote healthier living environments for the good of the public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in a regular session of council on June 27th, 2023 approved to purchase from FLOYD SERVICE COMPANY, INC Electrical Construction in the amount of \$200,000.00 using the American Rescue Plan Act Funds, after motion was made by Councilperson Brownie Caldwell, and second was made by Councilperson Darryl Heard; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dadeville, Alabama do hereby establish the American Rescue Plan Fund, a special revenue fund, to account for funds received from this federal legislation, in the amount of \$200,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council that the City Clerk is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary for the implementation and reporting all matters related to this purchase.
