

ORDINANCE 525

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of July, 2025, Johnny Crayton Jr, Jacobi and Kiera Wilkerson, Rachel Stamps Edwards, and Frederick Hutcherson , being the owners of all the real property hereinafter described, did file with the City Council asking that the said tracts or parcels of land be annexed to and become a part of the City of Dadeville; and

WHEREAS, the governing body did determine that it is in the public interest that said property be annexed to the City of Dadeville and it did further determine that all legal requirements for annexing said real property have been met pursuant for Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-24 , Code of Alabama;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DADEVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Dadeville, Alabama, finds and declares as the legislative body of the City that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City, and the citizens of the affected area, to bring the territory described in Section 2 of this ordinance into the City of Dadeville.

Section 2. The boundary line of the City of Dadeville, Alabama, be, and the same are hereby altered or rearranged so as to include all of the territory heretobefore encompassed by the corporate limits of the City of Dadeville, Alabama, and in addition thereto the following described territory, to-wit:

Woodyard Street, Dadeville, Alabama,

Parcels: 62.16.02.03.0.002.005, 62.16.02.03.0.000.002.041, 62.16.02.03
.0.000.002.0119, and 62.16.02.03.000.002.015.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published as provided by law, and a certified copy of the petition of property owners, shall be filed with the Probate Judge of Tallapoosa County, Alabama.

Section 4. The territory described in the ordinance shall become a part of the corporate limits of Dadeville, Alabama, upon publication of this ordinance as set forth in Section 3 above.
